### About the list

#### **Gendered Intelligence**

Gendered Intelligence (GI) is a registered charity that works to increase understandings of gender and improve the lives of trans people. There are multiple strands to our work:

- Youth & Community Services
- Professional and Educational Services
- Public Engagement

**Professional and Educational Services** refers primarily to the work we deliver to organisations or professional individuals who want to be more trans and non-binary inclusive both in terms of their services and their workplaces. This includes training, consultancy, events such as panel discussions and Q&As, and our network for therapists and counsellors.

**Youth & Community Services** covers our direct provision for trans and nonbinary people especially young trans, non-binary and gender questioning people. This includes youth work – regular groups, residentials, trips and activities, 1:1 support and mentoring for young trans people in educational environments; our parents and carers group; a helpline commissioned by several GICs for those on their waiting lists; one-off special projects, and our volunteering programmes

**Public Engagement** covers our work in the policy and media spheres, responding to consultations, to requests for interviews and expert opinion; media engagement; engaging our supporters, the general public, and others who may be interested in our work; and research.

### Prevalence Statistics <u>Approx 1:100 people fall under the broader trans umbrella</u> ONS 2021 Census Data

The 2021 census data released in Jan 2023 shows that overall, about 0.5% of the population said that their gender identity was different from their sex registered at birth (1 in 200). People aged 16 to 24 years were the most likely age group to have said that their gender identity was different from their sex registered at birth, with 1.00% (63,000) identifying as such. This compares with 0.54% (262,000) of the overall population. The proportion of people who identified as trans decreased with each successive age group, falling to 0.22% for those aged 75+. This is a common picture across LGBT+ statistics, and is thought to reflect that it has become progressively more possible to live as a visible LGBT+ person over time.

The 2018 government LGBT survey report by the Government Equalities Office says (p14) (our bold):

"There is currently no robust measure of the size of the trans population in the UK. Applying estimates of population prevalence from studies in other countries suggests that between 0.35% and 1% of the UK population might be trans, **although this does not include non-binary people**. ..."

Given that the report also says (p16):

"Of all respondents, 49% were men (including 3% trans men), 42% were women (including 3% trans women), and 7% were non-binary. The remaining respondents either had an 'other' gender identity (1%) or said that they did not know or preferred not to say (1%)", this indicates that non-binary may, in fact, be a majority identity amongst trans people and applying that to the 0.35% - 1% statistics gives a range <u>inclusive</u> of non-binary people, of at least 0.7% - 2%

### **Size and Distribution of Transgender and Gender Nonconforming Populations: A Narrative Review** (2019), Goodman, Adams, Corneil

Kreukels, Motmans & Coleman

This meta-analysis identifies a range with 1% at its centre, and acknowledges both that clinical studies capture only a proportion of the trans\* population and the trend towards more people identifying as trans\*:

"The literature addressing this topic spans five decades and presents data from 17 countries. On balance, the data indicate that people who self-identify as TGNC represent a sizable proportion of the general population with realistic estimates ranging from 0.1% to 2%, depending on the inclusion criteria and geographic location. Clinic-based studies seem to capture only a small subset of the TGNC population. Temporal trends show that TGNC population is undergoing rapid changes in terms of its size and in terms of its demographic characteristics."

### **Other Information**

Recent studies indicate that increasing numbers of young people in particular identify outside the gender binary, so 1% is likely to be conservative:

The May 2021 US report **Prevalence of Gender-Diverse Youth in an Urban School District** (American Academy of Paediatrics) indicates that 9.2% of teens don't identify with the binary, as reported here: <u>www.them.us/story/high-schooler-gender-diversity-study</u>
